Secretary Report & Website News:

Treasurers Report:

Bylaws:

Tom Maul has adopted these proposed changes, the language to be omitted and have **underlined in bold**, the language to be added. And in the highlighted area with comments will be remove from the by-laws. These by-laws will be amended and voted on at our April meeting. You can view our by-laws at <http://www.pvmustangs.net>

- Article III Section 1: There shall be one (1) type of membership: Active. **Active" member shall mean a current dues paying member.** All membership applications will be reviewed at club meetings for approval.
- Article IV Section 1: Dues will be \$15.00 **\$20.00** per year, due and payable on January 1st of each year. During the year, dues **for members joining** will be prorated \$1.25 per month. After July 1st, **membership** dues will include the months remaining during the current year, plus the next year's membership dues.
- Article V Section 2: The Vice-President will perform all the duties of the President in the absence of the President; carry out all directions of the President, **countersign club checks**, be responsible for the all club public relations, and responsible for the miscellaneous club items (i.e., banners, t-shirts and jackets.)
- Article V Section 6: The number of Directors shall be four. The number of Directors may be increased or decreased from time to time by amendment to these by-laws. The individual Directors may also change by amendment to these by-laws. **The individual Directors may also change by amendment to these by-laws.**

- Article VI Section 1: All **nominations** **nominees** for any office **and for director** must be an active member in good standing.
- Article VI Section 2: All elected and appointed officers **and directors** must remain in good standing and active for the duration of their term in office. All officers **and directors** will be elected at a meeting prior to the beginning of the new term and will take office the first day of the new term. These officers **and directors** will hold office for twelve months or until their successors are duly elected and qualified.
- Article VI Section 3: All officers **and directors** will have a term from January 1st to December thirty first of each year.
- Article VI Section 5: Election of officers **and directors** will be decided by a majority vote of all **active** members present and in good standing.
- Article VII Section 1: **The attendance of fifteen (15)** A **majority of** active members in good standing constitutes a quorum.
- Article VII Section 2: Regular membership meetings will be the **3rd 2nd** Tuesday of each month at a place and time set forth by the officers.
- Article VII Section 3: Special meetings can only be called by the President and or by **majority of the club** **the unanimous consent of 15 or more active members.**
- Article XI Section 1: The club constitution and by-laws may be amended **by a majority vote of the active member present** at any regular or special meeting of the membership, providing there is a quorum.

These Restated and Amended Constitution and By-laws were adopted by a majority vote of the active members present at a regularly held meeting on the _____ day of _____, 2007.
